Local Priests & Licensed Lay Ministers The number of hours and the amount of work done voluntarily by our local priest and the lay ministers is astounding! Hundreds of hours for worship, pastoral care and a variety of community ministry and preparation are given. Travel costs, and costs of materials needed for various ministries are mostly donated. Twice a year for LLM's (and all parishioners) and four times a year for our local priest, are training conferences at Melrose, costing \$70-\$100 per person.
