Mission in the Copper Coast

Drop-in ministry is growing in the parish as a whole. This is a vitally important ministry as it means the doors of the church and hall buildings are open, and caring people are on hand to listen and chat and provide a variety of wonderful activities. This ministry has a financial as well as a personal cost. The personal cost is to the people who give up time and often money from their own pockets to ensure this ministry happens. The financial costs are varied but not insignificant. Serendipity, Kerensa Community, Annies Shop, Sing-long and lunch, Morning Melodies and morning tea, require preparation, craft materials, or shelving, hanging racks and storage boxes, music, well maintained musical instruments, heating, cooling and lighting, a regular supply of tea, coffee, Milo, and lunch foods or cakes and biscuits. **The cost of ensuring these mission ministries are able to continue will be about \$2000 for this year.**
